## REMARKS

- \* Duration: 2 weeks
- \* Seat allocation: Up to 50 participants
- \* Participants should be all rank officers, NCOs (OR-7 and above) and equivalent civilians.
- \* The course is open to NATO, Pfp, MD, ICI, Partners across the Globe (PatG) members and countries that Türkiye has bilateral relationship (with an alternative training program).
- \* This course was accredited by NATO in 2008.
- \* 781 participants from 67 different countries have attended the course since 1999.
