The aim of the course is to prepare participants for missions/duties related emerging challenges in new security environment and to build up a comprehensive understanding of NATO Crisis Response Operation responding to Collective Security and Non-Article 5 in the light of current doctrines and best practices.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- ❖ Describe academic, political, humanitarian and military aspects of crisis management.
- ❖ Define fundamental principles of NATO Crisis Response Operations responding to Collective Security, Crisis Management, Cooperative Security and Non-Article 5.
- ❖ Identify international/national organizations roles, activities and initiatives in crisis management.
- ❖ Implement a comprehensive crisis response planning process according to the given scenarios.

REMARKS

- ❖ Duration: 2 weeks
- ❖ Seat allocation: 50 participants
- ❖ Participants should be all rank officers, NCOs and equivalent civilians.
- ❖ The course is open to NATO, PFP, MD, ICI, Partners across the Globe (PatG) members and countries that Turkey has bilateral relationship (with an alternative training program).

- ❖ 233 participants from 46 different countries have attended the course since 2012.
