AIM

The aim of the course is to orientate participants to multinational air operation/ exercise missions/duties with the provided knowledge on basic terminology, airspace control procedures, roles and the responsibilities and the traffic management procedures in a specified airspace environment.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- ❖ Be familiar with the roles and the responsibilities of civilian and military ATC units.
- ❖ Be familiar with the ATC procedures and applications.
- ❖ Be able to understand techniques of ATC procedures.
- ❖ Be familiar with the definitions and terminology used in ATC operations.

REMARKS

- ❖ Duration: 2 weeks
- ❖ Seat allocation: 24 participants
- ❖ Participants should be all rank officers, NCOs and equivalent civilians.
- ❖ The course is open to NATO, PfP, MD, ICI, Partners across the Globe (PatG) members and countries that Turkey has bilateral relations (with an alternative training program).
- ❖ This course was accredited by NATO in 2011.
- ❖ 259 participants from 35 different countries have attended the course since 1999.
