AIM

The aim of the course is to raise understanding of Energy Security factors (Energy Security Awareness, Critical Energy Infrastructure Protection and Energy Efficiency) relevant to NATO's Energy Security Agenda by introducing the fundamentals and analyzing energy security developments and their potential impacts on Alliance security and military operations at the operational level.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- ❖ Identify the links between energy and conflict with reference to geopolitics
- ❖ Identify the maritime security aspects of Energy Security
- ❖ Explain NATO's Agenda for Energy Security
- ❖ Understand the concept of Critical Energy Infrastructure Protection
- ❖ Identify hybrid threats to Critical Energy Infrastructure in different countries and regions

REMARKS

- ❖ Duration: 1 week
- ❖ Seat allocation: Up to 50 participants
- ❖ Participants should be all rank officers, NCOs (OR-7 and above) and equivalent civilians.
- ❖ The course is open to NATO, PFP, MD, ICI, Partners across the Globe (PatG) members and countries that Turkey has bilateral relations (with an alternative training program).
- ❖ 80 participants from 19 different countries have attended the course since 2018.
- ❖ Dress code: Daily uniform or combat uniform in classroom.
