- * Describe the fundamentals of gender perspective and implementation of UNSCR 132.
- * Comprehend why gender perspective is a key component in achieving sustained success of military operations.
- * Understand the human rights have implications for both personal and collective responsibility in peacekeeping operations.
- * Define what identifiable, concrete steps can be taken to ensure a gender in peace support operations.

REMARKS

- * Seat allocation: 50 participants
- * Participants should be all rank officers, NCOs and equivalent civilians.
- * The course is open to NATO, PfP, MD, ICI and Partners across the Globe (PatG) members and countries that Türkiye has bilateral relationship.
